Council Committee Notes – Street/Sidewalks/Playground

Notes on Discussions:

1. Old Issues:

- a. **APPROVED:** Holiday Lighting: plan submitted 01 29 2009 to committee for review has been approved. (v)
- b. Missing signage at northbound Rt. 3 and Old Fair grounds Way: Motorists are failing to yield to oncoming turning traffic at this intersection. A sign was in this location indicating the requirement to “yield” but had fallen and not replaced. **VDOT will replace the sign.**
- c. **COMPLETED:** Request for school bus stop at S. Main\Mary Ball Road corridor: VDOT has placed “school bus stop ahead” signage along southbound lanes. This is a 4 lane, 55 mph zone.

2. New Issues:

- a. Lighting on Black Stump Rd.: this came up during the Nov 2008 TC meeting . There was discussion from Mayor Smith that there should be street lighting on this road and has been pursued with Dominion.
 - We have Dominion's engineering estimate for 4 light upgrades plus 1 new pole and light. This lights the whole street to just before the cul de sac albeit not very elegantly.
 - Recommendation that Council authorize street lighting if funding is available.
- b. Staff and Committee discussed several recent complaints regarding properties that may be in violation of the Town’s Ordinance for Nuisances. It was discussed that staff put together a list of properties that are in violation and send notices to all at one time.
- c. Discussed potential to add brackets to Main St. light and phone poles to display seasonal flags. Staff will review what requirements are, if any, from Dominion Power and Verizon to add attachments to their equipment.
- d. Provided information on 03 03 2009 damage to the Main St. island closest to the Irvington intersection. Staff will pursue additional information from Robert Harper,

VDOT Brookvale office to see if any snow plows may have been involved. Photos included. (v)

- Recommend Council approve the removal of this Main Street island and fill it in to match surrounding pavers.
- e. Council member Nunn discussed the Town's capability, if any, to require the movement of Sara Brown's business sign. Staff recommended no action.

Recommendations to Council:

1. Approval of 2009 Holiday Lighting Plan for installation and removal.
2. Recommendation to add street lighting on Black Stump Rd. if funding is available.
3. Recommend removal of the Main Street island closest to Irvington Road and fill it in to match surrounding pavers.
