Notes on Discussions:

- a. Placement of flowers along downtown Main ST.
- b. “Spot blight”, eyesore properties, tall grass – asked staff to investigate possible violations and follow up with previous notices.
- c. Committee recommendation made to the Lancaster Library regarding the need to fix their exit to School ST.
- d. Revisited damage to Main St. island closest to the Irvington intersection. Staff will get repair cost information for council and move forward with removal.
- e. Flags – an update from staff was given on the placement of flags throughout Town. Everything is on schedule and it was decided to put up the remainder of brackets.
- f. General discussion of recent sidewalk damage and responsible party.
- g. Request by Chesapeake Boat Basin to remove the existing “Kilmarnock Wharf” sign on the pole at the corner of Main and Waverly. Decision was made to leave the existing sign as is.
- h. Lighting on Black Stump RD – This item was postponed at March Council meeting until funding became available. Funding is now available in the upcoming budget (July 1) to carry out the lighting plan. Staff was instructed to proceed pending council approval

Recommendations to Council:

1. Recommend the Black Stump Road Lighting Plan be authorized to proceed.

Recommended for further study:

1. Committee recommends that staff investigate the use of “in memory of” Christmas wreaths for holiday street decoration.
