Notes on Discussions:

1. Old Issues:

- a. Memorial Pavers: The Master Gardeners will present two designs for the playground garden, including the location of the plaques at the next meeting of the Kiwanis -Jan. 21st at 7:30 AM at St. Andrews Presbyterian Church.

2. New Issues:

- a. Holiday Lighting:
 - i. In anticipation of the 2009 holiday season, Staff will provide a written plan to Town Council with dates, actions and any required expenditures necessary to fulfill the requested plan. Have asked Council member Nunn to coordinate any additional expectations from Town Council.
 - ii. Expectations stated to date are: 1) have all lighting installed and illuminated by Thanksgiving. 2) Install lighting along N. Main from the municipal lot to School Street (to connect with N. Main up to Old Fair grounds Way).
- b. Community Block Development Grant project along Mary Ball Highway: Reviewed the next steps of this project.
- c. Harvey Lane renaming request: The owner of these parcels is requesting a name change of the road to coincide with a naming changes for the units. Will recommend to Town Council to support this request to Lancaster County who would implement any changes.
- d. New markings in merger lanes on N. Main Street: Reviewed that VDOT will be painting arrows in the merger lane to help motorists better indentify the direction of merger.
- e. Culvert Damage at 2nd and Claybrook Avenues: VDOT will be address correcting this.
- f. Missing signage at northbound Rt. 3 and Old Fair grounds Way: Motorists are failing to yield to oncoming turning traffic at this intersection. A sign was in this location indicating the requirement to “yield” but had fallen and not replaced. VDOT will replace the sign.
- g. Request for school bus stop at S. Main\Mary Ball Road corridor: VDOT will place “school bus stop ahead” signage along southbound lanes. This is a 4 lane, 55 mph zone.

Recommendations to Council:

1. Recommend to Town Council to forward to Lancaster County approval of a name change to Harvey Lane.

Recommended for further study:
