Notes on Discussions:

1. Discussed state denial of the funding application submitted for the relocation of the outfall pipe.
2. Hospital Well was discussed. A Waterworks Construction Permit has been issued by the VDH and staff has sent a letter to Draper Aden. (v)
3. Staff needs to create a log of water and sewer issues.
4. Water and sewer master plan was discussed. Completion is near.
5. Mrs. Nunn explained that she had wanted to hold the water bill for the Bowling Alley on Cralle Crt.
6. Ben Burton & Clay Holcomb discussed their interest in the Town running sewer down Waverly ave to the end. Meet again in two weeks to further discuss.
7. Main Street Gifts contested water bill was discussed and was required to be paid. (v)
8. Discussed the maintenance boost for the WWTP. A list of items needing attention will be left with the Chief Operator.
9. Discussed quotes for alarm system at WWTP. (v)
10. James discussed the need to jet out a line on Waverly Ave.

Recommendations to Council:

- Recommend that council approve the purchase of an alarm system for the WWTP as shown on the attached quote from Commonwealth Engineering & Sales.
- Recommend that Council approve the jetting of a sewer line on Waverly Ave by Tri-State Utilities to be performed in the near future. Cost is roughly \$3,500.00.

- Request for sewer line to the end of Waverly Avenue.
