



## Town of Kilmarnock Council Committee Notes – Police/Public Safety

### **Notes on Discussions:**

1. Chief Bedell distributed copies of his August Police report.
2. The Committee discussed a minor incident involving a juvenile who threw something from the open platform on the rear of the Trolley and agreed that current policies are sufficient to deal with this for now.
3. Chief Bedell reported that his department is able to conduct its own CPR training in house and that his staff would soon be current in its certifications.
4. The new police car that was ordered in July still has not been delivered but could show up any day. (Was delivered the next day, is now being outfitted for use.)
5. Mayor Booth asked staff to investigate whether VDOT removes animal carcasses from the highway and whether Cralle Court can be returned to two-way status from end to end.
