Notes on Discussions:

1. TM Saunders told the Committee that he has had a very preliminary conversation with some members of the Community Library foundation regarding their possible interest in acquiring part of the Town Centre property for a new building. He said they have some research to complete before deciding if this option is viable and he expects to hear back from them soon.
2. TM Saunders told the Committee that Rappahannock Community College is investigating the possibility of opening a workforce development campus in or near Kilmarnock. He said he expects to be meeting with college and county officials about this soon.
3. Council member Nunn gave a summary of her progress raising money for the Dog Park and said that she hoped work could commence soon.
4. There was some discussion of how best to proceed on the "People's Park" concept that was raised during the September Council meeting. Ms. Nunn stated that a multi-use park has long been considered for the Town Centre lot and has just been on hold for the last year or so due to the soft economy. The Committee agreed to begin drawing up a list of names of those who might serve on a Park Advisory Committee.
