



Council Committee Notes - Water/Sewer

Notes on Discussions:

1. Mr. Seagle reported a significant sewer line repair in the ravine behind the Bellevue/Oakridge section of Town which required significant assistance from Franklin Mechanical to accomplish.
2. TM Saunders reported that he is still waiting to hear from VDH regarding its requirements relative to private irrigation wells inside the town. (That letter was received later in the week and is included in the packet.)
3. Mr. Saunders reported that the cleaning and painting of the Church Street water tank was complete except for part of the graphics which should be completed soon.
4. The Committee reviewed a complaint regarding excessive noise on 10/23/2010 @ 6:30-6:45 AM by Mr. Lee Lindsey, whose family has property approximately 1000 feet from the Town's WWTP. After discussion the Committee agreed that Mr. Saunders should send Mr. Lindsey expressing its opinion that the sound coming from the WWTP is very moderate and does not constitute a nuisance that requires mitigation.
5. The Committee was advised that construction of the Mary Ball Road/Grace Hill sewer pump station is proceeding on schedule. (Wet well was installed 11/11.)
6. The Committee was also advised:
 - a. VPDES permit reissuance process continues as expected.
 - b. Repairs pending:
 - i. Manhole on Bellevue
 - ii. Pump at Harvey Lane lift station
 - iii. Irrigation meter for residence on Waverly
 - c. Status of auto transfer switch on WWTP generator (still pending)
 - d. Cross Connection Control Program: will be sending out follow-ups within 30 days
 - e. Personnel information update.
