Notes on Discussions:

1. Chief Bedell distributed copies of his report and statistics from October.
2. TM Saunders reported that he had recently been informed by the local VDOT superintendent that VDOT continues to respond to requests to remove animal carcasses from streets and rights-of-way. He was also informed that the one-way status of Cralle Court could be reversed but that there is a process to follow to do so.
3. There was some discussion of a complaint regarding excessive noise (motorcycle) from a residence on Irvington Road. Chief Bedell believes the problem has been taken care of.
4. There has been a citizen complaint regarding loitering on the cul de sac portion of Black Stump Road. TM Saunders reported that VDOT will trim vegetation in the area which should make it easier for police to monitor the situation.
