### **Council Committee Notes – Town Centre/Government Center**

#### **Notes on Discussions:**

1. TM Saunders reported that he had not heard from either the library or the Community College concerning any interest in Town facilities or property in the last month, though he expects that there will be developments along both lines in the next 60 to 90 days.
2. Councilmember Nunn gave an update on fund raising for the Dog Park.
3. There was discussion on how best to proceed with building a plan for a “People’s Park” on the Town Centre property. Mr. Saunders asked for suggestions for potential Park Advisory Committee members.
4. TM Saunders stated that although it may take years to renovate or replace Town Hall with more suitable facilities, the situation with the Police Department and ATM Cockrell’s offices in the small building has reached unacceptable conditions. He described the HVAC and bathroom as substandard and possibly unhealthy. One option would be to move them into the main building by partitioning space in the area currently used for Council meetings and use another local meeting space for meetings. .
