

Town Centre Park is open from dawn to dusk.

Waterworks is open seasonally from May to October, 10 am to 8 pm.

Open flames and grills are prohibited throughout the Park.

- Children under the age of 12 must be accompanied by an adult over the age of 18 and must be under adult supervision at all times.
- Smoking is allowed only in the designated area at the Pavillion.
- Alcohol use is NOT permitted unless at a licensed event.

Please observe and follow the Town Centre Park rules for the safety and enjoyment of everyone.

- The Town Centre Park is a Drug Free Zone.
 The Town Centre Park is a safe play zone.
- The Half Shell Stage is for performances ONLY. No bikes, skateboards, scooters or roller blades on or in the amphitheater.
- Bicycles are permitted in parking lots only, not on sidewalks or plazas.
- Please help keep our park beautiful and do not litter.
- Do not deface or vandalize the Park. Let's keep it beautiful for future generations.
- Companion animals must stay in designated areas. Dogs are to be in Scottie's Yard only.
 Service animals are allowed throughout the Town Centre Park.

- The Town Centre Park is a safe play zone.

 No bullying allowed. Anyone using abusive or insulting language will be asked to leave.
- Inappropriate use of equipment in River Play and/or Waterworks that may result in physical injury is prohibited including:
 - Bats and Balls: wooden, plastic, metals bats and basketballs, baseballs, golf balls and playground balls.
- Games that involve tackling, tagging pushing, shoving, hitting, grabbing, pulling, knocking down, tripping, throwing, or climbing or jumping on others.
- Temporary shelters, such as tents, tarps or canopies, are not allowed without permits from the Town of Kilmarnock.

- No overnight parking.
- Park vehicles in designated parking spaces.
- Usage permits are required for groups of 20 or more requesting exclusive use of a park area. Permit fees are required.

Any violations of this article will be found guilty of a class 4 misdemeanor. In addition, such person may be immediately ejected from the park, building or other facility wherein the violation occurred.
