**Discussion items:**

1. Staff reports: Wayne Kent: We experienced several leaks-all of which have been resolved (water leaks on Church St., Chase St., and a sewer main leak.)
2. Regarding the sewer improvement project on S. Main between Augusta St. and Irvington Rd., the Town has responded to several requests for information from VDOT. No final determinations as yet.
3. Regarding our VPDES permit application, we are just waiting on their response.
4. TM Saunders and TA Stamm will seek pricing from other contractors regarding the cost to repaint the interior of the Church Street elevated tank. We will use these as the basis for a claim against Southern Corrosion.

**FYI:**

1. The School Street lift station pump has been returned from the supplier and is waiting on installation.
2. There has been an issue with sewer blockage on the east side of North Main Street where several lines come together. Blockages have been related to grease. We are continuing to work with the businesses without grease traps as part of our Fats, Oils and Grease program.
3. FOG inspection process update: There are 3-4 additional letters to go to noncomplying locations.
