Discussion items:

1. Staff reports: PJ Jones: Inspections of sewer mains that travel through woods to the WWTP have begun. These areas are in need of brush removal to ensure access to the lines. Wayne Kent: Things are going well and the School St. pumps are back on line.
2. An update on the sewer improvement project on S. Main between Augusta St. and Irvington Rd. shows that we now have VDOT's approval. Bid process may begin by month's end.
3. The committee was updated on problems with the underground power feed to Hospital well. We are working with Dominion VA Power to address maintenance.
4. The committee was apprised of connection issues at several new sites.

2. There is a sewer line root control experiment under way.
3. FOG inspection process update: initial inspections are complete.
4. A broken water meter cover at Salon Allure was identified. Staff will install a new cover.
