Discussion items:

1. TM Saunders advised the committee that plans for extending sewer laterals on Waverly Avenue have been submitted to VDOT for review. He expects this phase of plan review to take about a month.
2. Saunders reported a recent water main leak on Clark Lane had been quickly repaired but the rushing water had undermined some of the pavement and he is waiting to hear from VDOT as to how much of the street the Town will be required to repave.
3. The committee discussed the success of recent attempts to mitigate blower noise at WWTP and asked TM Saunders to draft a position statement for review the next time the committee meets.
4. Staff reports: no members of staff were available to make reports in person but TM Saunders reported that the water and wastewater systems have been performing properly and that there are no current acute issues to discuss.

FYI:

1. Bill Rosenbaum gave an update on progress on the Wiggins Ave. force main replacement. Almost all of the pipe has been laid and connections at the pump station will soon be all that is required for completions. VDOT has withdrawn a request to repave a portion of Wiggins Avenue. Mr. Rosenbaum submitted a revised generator replacement bid request advertisement that can be published soon.
2. TM Saunders reported that there has been no progress on radio read meter retrofit in the past month; contractor trials have not yet resulted in an actionable proposal.
