Discussion items:

1. The committee was provided an update on the status of Norris Pond pump and controls. The pump is installed and we are researching the appropriate controls for this new equipment.
2. The committee was updated on car wash fluids spill. While this did not have any negative ramifications, we still have some residual color in the digester but it is slowly being processed out.
3. The committee was updated on the status of the Wiggins Ave. lift station pump repair. The removed pump will be repaired and a new pump has been ordered (~ \$27,000 of capital expense). The repaired pump will be used as a spare for back up purposes and should be available in ~ 2 weeks. The new pump is due in ~ 8 weeks.
4. Staff has prepared a list of obsolete parts following the major organization of the public works building and requests authorization to place on GovDeals for sale.
5. Staff reports:
 1. Pat Chenoweth, WWTP: Awaiting quotes on several items: drives on lime machine drive on EQ pumps on 'A' basin
 2. PJ Jones, Public Works: Have identified a water leak on Dogwood and will use Code Red to announce shut off and restoration. Worked very well.
