3. The committee was updated on the progress of the Dogwood and Chase sewer main upgrade project. It is 75-80% complete.

5. Staff reports: Pat Chenoweth reported that one of the sewer reactor tanks had received some recent maintenance by the manufacturer which improved performance and reduced the noise potential.
