**Discussion Items:**

1. TM Saunders advised the Committee that the proposed Waverly Ave and Chase Street sewer line upgrades are still in the hands of contractors. Work is proceeding on obtaining the easements that are needed.
2. Saunders reported that replacement aerator arms for the reactor tanks at the WWTP have been ordered and should be delivered soon. The existing arms have become fragile due to corrosion from being constantly immersed in the activated sludge tanks. The parts that are being replaced have been in service since 1997.
3. Saunders advised the committee that a 4" water main at the intersection of Lloyd Lane and Waverly Avenue had failed recently and had been repaired. The leak occurred inside of a sleeve under the street, necessitating a complicated repair.
4. Saunders reported that the crew from Southern Corrossion, Inc. had arrived on the site of the Radio well and begun the process of pressure washing and painting that tank.
5. Staff reports: Pat Chenoweth, WWTP reported that her department continues to operate well within our DEQ permit limits.
