Discussion Items:

1. The committee discussed the status of the DEQ consent order. We believe we have reached the most equitable solution to the order. Council will receive the latest update at the Sept. 15th meeting.
2. The committee was updated on the progress on Main Street sewer improvement study. The engineering and early survey work is underway to determine what options may exist.
3. Staff reports: PJ Jones: Our annual inspection from the State Dept. of Health on our water system was successfully held on Sept 4th with no issues.

FYI:

1. The repaired pump is back at Wiggins Ave. lift station. New pump shipped Aug. 29th from Sydnor Pump. Installation was Sept. 5th by Franklin Mechanical. This lift station is now in its normal pump configuration.
2. Norris Pond well station pump controls have been ordered. This will provide more consistent pump usage and performance.
3. We will be replacing the backup Equalization (EQ) basin pumps at WWTP. The existing “back up” pumps have been put into service when the 2003 and 1997 pumps were recently removed. Capital funds are available for this purchase.
4. We have a new hire on board at the WWTP. Trainee Howard Carter has gotten off to a very promising start.
