Discussion Items:

1. TM Saunders reported that he and Town Attorney Stamm have been working on acquiring the needed easements for Waverly Ave sewer line upgrades but have a few details yet to do before work can begin.
2. Saunders advised that the first of the two pumps in the Wiggins Ave. pump station will be pulled October 10 for machining of the pump impeller, which should take about a week. He hopes the entire operation can be accomplished by the end of the month. In the meantime the Public Works and WWTP staffs have test run the stand-by pumps and everything seems to be ready for the short time when only one pump will be operational in the pump station.
3. Pat Chenoweth reported that the first set of air diffuser drop arms on the Schreiber units at the WWTP have been replaced and the benefits were immediately apparent. Pat hopes the second set of arms can be installed by the end of the week.
4. Pat Chenoweth, WWTP & Wayne Kent, Utilities reported that all is well in their departments.
