Discussion items:

1. Staff reports: PJ Jones: Waste water treatment plant has been running well. Staff repaired a 1930's era section of water main that had ruptured on Mablewood. There is a pump repair underway at one of the two sewerage pumps at the School St. lift station.
2. The committee was updated on the sewer improvement project on S. Main between Augusta St. and Irvington Rd. We are waiting on feedback from VDOT on the type of manhole that could be needed on Irvington Rd.
1. The committee was updated that our VPDES permit application is now complete. Our permit expires October of 2016.
2. The committee was updated on the ongoing issues with Church Street elevated tank interior paint job.

FYI:

1. Our WWTP lab inspection certification allows the Town to test certain parameters. The inspection was completed Oct. 20th and we are awaiting the report by the end of November.
2. Our FOG inspection process has shown a few businesses without the proper equipment. A letter to all non-compliant businesses will go out by the end of November and gives them time and support to become compliant.
3. NN Brewing has received the needed rezoning from Lancaster County. Kilmarnock verified our "pump and haul" agreement for the County.
