Discussion Items:

1. T M Saunders reported that the Town is still working to acquire one easement before the Waverly Ave sewer upgrade job can commence.
2. After a year of work the Wiggins Ave. pump station upgrade and force main replacement has been completed. The last pump to be modified and renovated has been reinstalled and brought on line. This most critical node of the sewer system is now in better condition and more capable than it has ever been. With pending changes to the generator specifications, a revised bid has been requested of the low bidder now that both pumps are installed. Additionally, the committee recommends that filtration baskets be installed to prevent larger debris from entering the pump impellers and causing damage.
3. The last Schreiber diffuser arm has been installed at the treatment plant, putting both reactors back in full time normal status. In the meantime all monitoring test results have been in the acceptable range.
4. The committee reviewed recent issues with a blocked lateral at a Main Street business. Bill Rosenbaum updated the team on his work (independent) with that firm to improve sewer performance and some scenarios for how a new lateral or force main could be accomplished.
5. Staff has returned to full strength.
6. Pat Chenoweth, WWTP & Wayne Kent, Utilities reported no issues.
