Discussion Items:

1. The committee was updated on next steps regarding the DEQ consent order. We have reviewed the draft of corrective actions required by DEQ. There appears to be no new spending other than process monitors which we would be purchasing anyway.
2. Progress Engineers have nearly delivered the final survey report (one line needed) for the Main Street sewer improvement study. Any solutions will require an easement across private property to reach the sewerage main on Irvington Road.
3. For VA Dept. of Health grants for sewerage system tie ins, the Town can support the required match of the local applicants through fee waivers.
4. Staff requested to initiate enforcement work through our Fats, Oils and Grease ordinance.
5. Staff reports: A leak was repaired on Wiggins Avenue and a 60' extension of the water main was completed on Dogwood Lane.
