Discussion items:

1. Staff reports: PJ Jones: the WWTP continues to perform very well; Wayne Kent: 50' of water lines were replaced on Clark Lane & we are waiting on the return of the School St. lift station pump from Sydnor Hydraulics in Richmond.
2. The committee was updated on the sewer improvement project on S. Main between Augusta St. and Irvington Rd. VDOT has asked for drawings on how this would interface with Irvington Rd. Drawings have been developed and are on their way to the Town.
3. We have heard from VPDES on our permit application asking for some minor data. The permit is on track.
4. TM Saunders and Town Attorney Stamm are discussing the next steps regarding filing a claim to Southern Corrosion on the Church Street elevated tank interior painting.

FYI:

1. The WWTP lab inspection report has been returned. We are evaluating the cost of compliance with new mandates vs. outsourcing these few remaining tests. TM Saunders was authorized by the committee to make the final determination.
2. Fats, Oils and Grease inspection letters to noncomplying locations have begun. 75% of the first rounds of letter recipients have responded-mostly looking for education on how to comply. Another 7-8 letters remain to be sent.
3. There are bricks coming out of the crosswalk at Main and Irvington. Staff to assess.
