Notes on Discussions:

1. Committee Chairperson Umphlett and TM Saunders reviewed the status of the Town’s preparations for weather-related emergencies. Saunders reported that, with the possible exception of the generator for the Wiggins Avenue sewer lift station which will be replaced soon, the Town is reasonably well prepared for power outages that last an extended amount of time, with back-up generators at all critical nodes. The one item that warrants attention is providing fuel to police cars and public works vehicles if all of the gas stations are closed. Saunders agreed to look into a solution to that problem before the next meeting of the committee.
