Notes on Discussions:

1. TM Saunders reported that ads seeking bids for the Wiggins Ave generator replacement will be in the Record this week and he hopes to have bids in by the middle of July and a generator in place by Labor Day.
2. Saunders reported that staff had discovered some problems with the new generator at the hospital well (Well #3) and had called in the supplier to investigate. He believes the trouble has been diagnosed and repaired but Public Works staff will keep a close eye on the operation of this machine.
3. Chairperson Umphlett asked if any progress had been made in providing for fuel for police cars and public works vehicles if all of the gas stations are closed in the case of a prolonged blackout. Saunders reported that an agreement has been reached with a local petroleum products supplier to supply fuel to Town vehicles in such circumstances but the agreement has not yet been formalized. He will continue to work towards this goal and report to the next meeting of the Committee.
