



## **Council Committee Notes – Streets, Sidewalks and Playgrounds**

### **Notes on Discussions:**

1. TM Saunders reported that the median island repair at Main and Irvington had finally been completed.
2. Saunders reported that he has engaged the services of DBI street sweeping company to sweep Steptoe's District next week. Eight hours was the minimum allowed, so he hopes they will be able to get all of Main Street, from Old Fairgrounds Way to Wiggins Avenue and perhaps some of Church Street and Irvington Road in the time available.
3. Susan Cockrell gave an update on the status of maintenance items at the town playground. She is meeting with the "Moms Group" next week to see how much money they have raised to help with playground maintenance.
4. Saunders reported that a four foot chain link fence across the far end of the playground lot will cost ~\$1400 installed. Councilmember Moubray asked for time to look at the site before making a recommendation.
5. Councilmember Moubray and TM Saunders agreed to meet on the Town Centre lot to try to identify a place for a dog park that might not be in the way of other plans and grading projects. They will report their findings to Council

### **Recommendations to Council:**

- Consider furnishing a dog park on the Town Center lot now, rather than wait until the entire site is developed.

### **Recommended for further study:**

- Investigate rear lot line fencing of the playground.
