Discussion items:

1. The committee was apprised that the next meeting with LPDA on Town Centre Park would be Sept. 9th at 2PM.
2. The committee was apprised that David Brown with VDOT will research what would be required to re-engineer the Main Street storm drains to prevent situational flooding near Rivah Antiques and Collectibles.
3. The committee was informed on progress with rainwater harvesting. A rain collection tank is being delivered with funding, in part, from the Kilmarnock Garden Club. We will provide a connection and stand to enable gravity feeding of the water into mobile tanks.
4. The Planning Commission will hold a public hearing at its Sept. 14 meeting to consider rezoning 139 S. Main St. from R-2 to C-1.

FYI:

1. Existing sidewalk repairs now updated on website.
2. The town has received citizen feedback that Kamps Lane is not pedestrian friendly.
3. The civic group signs on the entrance to town are outside of the town’s limits on private property and not maintained by the Town.
4. Staff will pursue a cleanup and refreshing of the four “Welcome to Kilmarnock” signs.
