Discussion Items:

1. Staff provided information on several VA ordinances that limit the size, location and duration of local election signage. Research continues on any jurisdictions that limit the amount of individual signs.
2. Committee members reviewed any new feedback on the playground.
3. TM Saunders reported on increasing the number of handicapped spaces in the downtown area. There could be a space on Main Street converted from curb side parking to handicapped. The committee determined not to take any actions at this time.
4. The committee members discussed potential actions to address work vehicles/equipment/trailers in residential yards and asked staff to research ordinances relating to storage of RV, boats on residential properties as a comparison.
5. T M Saunders reported on actions to assist farmers with traffic control when moving large equipment through town.
6. T M Saunders reported on discussions with Frank Pleva and Wally Beachamp regarding Lancaster County approaches to a Kilmarnock ordinance concerning derelict structures. More research will be conducted by the County.
